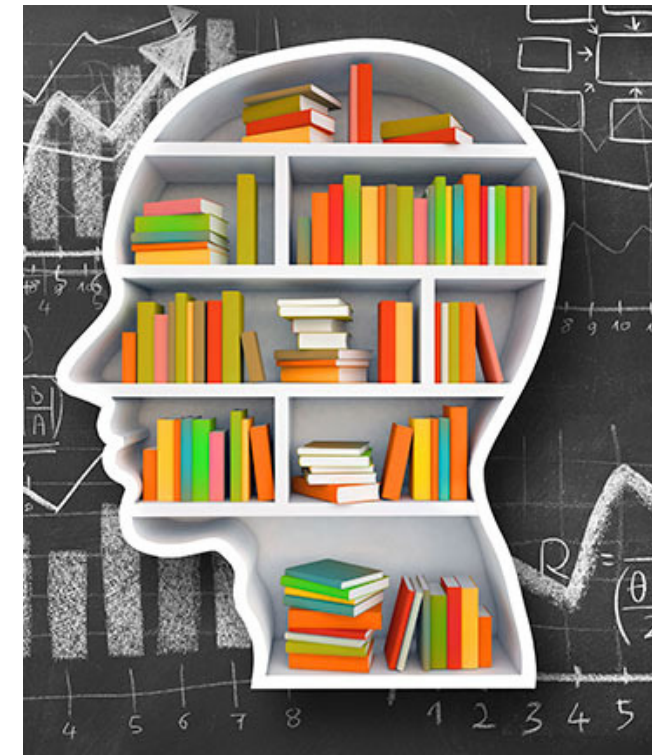


STUDENTS OF THE MONTH

This year, teachers want to recognise you for your positive behaviours and improvement. This is based on the ATL skills, which include: Thinking Skills, Social Skills, Self-Management Skills, Communication Skills, and Research Skills. Every month, up to five students will be selected based on how well they are doing or how much they have improved!



Thinking Skills:

You can show your abilities in this area by learning and understanding new information, creating original ideas, and using skills in multiple contexts!

Social Skills:

You can show your social skills here by taking responsibility for your actions, respecting others, or working effectively with other people. It's more than just talking to other people.

Self-Management Skills:

Can you show that you can use your time wisely? Do you know what a deadline is? What about managing your own behaviours? If so, you're showing you have potential at self-management skills.

Communication Skills:

You can show you have communication skills by listening to and following directions. You also show this when you know which word to use in different contexts.

Research Skills:

Show the teachers that you're developing research skills by creating plans or collecting and recording information for your projects. Noticing connections to something else helps, too, because you can find more information!
